The Findlay Kiwanis Scholarship was established in 1974 to support Hancock County students in their pursuit of a college education. The scholarship was originally established to honor Fred Brucklacher, a long time Secretary and Treasurer of the Findlay Kiwanis Club. The scholarship is funded by the Findlay Kiwanis Club through projects such as the annual Kiwanis Pancake Day, Purse Bingo and through donations from members. Since its inception, over \$230,000 in scholarships have been awarded.

This year, the Findlay Kiwanis will award scholarships in the amount of \$2,500 for full-time students pursuing a four year degree, a two-year degree or a technical certificate.

CRITERIA

- 1) Only Hancock County residents are eligible.
- 2) Scholarships are awarded based upon the following factors:
 - Financial need
 - Academic success & rigor
 - Extracurricular activities & community involvement
- 3) Findlay Kiwanis members and their immediate family are not eligible.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Complete (please type or print) and submit this application prior to March 31, 2026.
2. PDF format is required for all submitted documents.
3. An official high school transcript is required. The transcript may either accompany the application or be sent directly to the Findlay Kiwanis Scholarship Committee. If ACT / SAT score is not included on transcript, please provide it separately.
4. Two personal recommendations are required. Recommendations may either accompany the application or be sent directly to the Findlay Kiwanis Scholarship Committee.
5. Financial need is a criterion in awarding this scholarship. For this reason, it is important to accurately provide all financial information.

Incomplete applications, those lacking all supporting documentation, those not in PDF format and those not received via email will not be considered.
